ABOUT CHEERCON EVENTS



ENTERING A CHEERCON EVENT

REGISTRATIONS

CheerCon uses Hit Zero for all event registrations. Please ensure ALL details are updated and correct as we use this for contact, postage and invoicing.

Registrations close 6 weeks prior to Icebreaker series, 7 weeks prior to State, World Experience and CL events, and 8 weeks prior to Nationals. Hit Zero will lock registrations midnight AEDT on these dates. If this is your first time using Hit Zero, CheerCon can provide you with instructions.

ENTERING SCHOLASTIC & UNIVERSITY CLUBS

Scholastic or University Teams cannot be registered under an Allstar Program. A separate 'club' must be registered on Hit Zero, and all teams must be entered under this club.

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT

If you have decided to take advantage of our early bird offer, your invoice will need adjusting after you finalise your entries. We will keep a record and manually do this for you within 24 business hours of your registration. Remember, if you are attending more than one CheerCon event (which we hope you are!) and want to take advantage of this deal, you need to purchase the special per event.

WORK ORDERS

Within three days of registration closing, A first draft of the work order Draft 1 is provided. We aim to complete the final work order within a fortnight of closing registrations.

ORDER OF EVENTS

Event schedules will be confirmed once entries have closed. Each event and venue are unique and will vary from 1-3 days with multiple halls where required. We encourage everyone to ask families to leave Friday evening. Saturday and Sunday available for each event.

CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

- The ACSA minimum team number requirements must be met when registering teams. If your team has less than the minimum number required by the ACSA age grid, you can still enter but must pay for the minimum number of athletes required.
- All programs must agree to the terms outlined in the official CheerCon Club waiver.
- The same routine cannot be entered twice (i.e. in two different sections).
- Each team is to compete only once per section for a 1-day event and twice for cheer teams' level 1+ at Champions League.
- All competitors perform at their own risk.
- All teams, programs, coaches and advisors should have an emergency response plan in the event of an injury and know where first aid is at each competition.
- Please take any concerns on the day to Danielle & Alex Jimenez.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are made in full when requested prior to the event. After this, we have a no refund or transfer policy, and your invoice is 100% final. This invoice must be paid in full on or before the final registration date. Gym owners are responsible for relaying this message to their athletes, as no discounts or refunds will be given if athletes are unable to attend between registration closing and the event date.

Each athlete will be individually checked by CheerCon Staff when arriving at the competition and at each time they attend warm-up. This allows us to keep an accurate record of attendees and participants. Any extra crossovers or athletes added at these times will also be invoiced to the club after the event.

*Any Unpaid/unregistered invoices will be sent to debt collection if not paid in full by the event date

INSURANCE AND WAIVERS

CheerCon does not provide personal indemnity insurance or collect a waiver per athlete. Instead, the waiver is agreed to when the gym owner finalises registrations for each event. This waiver acknowledges that as a gym, you have insurance for every athlete, coach & gym owner attending the event and have collected signed participation contracts/waivers from all parties. This waiver must include permission to take and use photos and videos at our events. It is essential that all gyms check their current insurance and waivers to ensure you are covered for all external events and not just for activities within your own premises.

■ COACHES & GYM OWNERS' REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- All coaches, assistant coaches, and gym owners must;
 - · Have a valid WWCC (Working with Children Check) or equivalent (unless under 18yrs).
 - Have and wear their photo ID with their coach pass at the event. Proof of age, license or any card with a photo is acceptable.
 - Be a registered coach for your club on HitZero.
- A valid IASF coach credential number must be provided for all official cheer coaches responsible for a team.
- Gym Owners do not need to have IASF credentials but do need to provide proof they are the gym owner, e.g. business card.
- Dance Coaches are not required to have IASF credentials.
- School Teachers do not need a WWCC but will need to provide their teacher's number.
- All teams will need a dedicated music player. This person can be any registered gym owner, coach or athlete at the event. If over 18yrs, this person must have a valid WWCC.
- There will now be a cap on the number of coaches a club can enter. An allowance of 3 coaches for the first routine and an additional 2 coaches per routine thereafter. A max of 20 coaches will be allowed per club.
- Junior Coaches/staff will be assessed on a case by case scenario based on the size of the club / teams attending the comp. If we deem there are too many Junior coaches/staff for a club already, we will cease handing out passes. Junior Coaches/Staff are not able to access the Coaches room.

ATHLETES 18+

Due to the ACSA Age grid now allowing 14+ for Open divisions we feel it is important to encourage athletes competing in these teams to have a WWCC.

It is likely that from 2025 this will be mandatory.

ATHLETE, COACH & GYM OWNER BEHAVIOUR

- Athletes, coaches and gym owners of teams are expected to exhibit the utmost sportsmanship, respect
 and support throughout the event.
- Actions that exhibit excessive boasting, a delay in competition, poor sportsmanship, or unprofessional behaviour may be penalised by event judges.
- Teams, please wear the appropriate uniform/costume when collecting awards.
- The warm-up area at our events is not a waiting room for athletes or coaches.
- All participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner that displays good sportsmanship throughout the event.
- The coaches room that is provided is for Senior Coaches/staff only. No Athletes, family members or Junior Coaches/ staff are to enter the coaches room.

DIVISIONS

AGE GRID & DIVISIONS

CheerCon offers all ACSA Divisions & Age Grids. In addition, CheerCon offers CheerStars and DanceStars.

Out of Age Athletes Policy

Teams can have 1 out of age athlete.

If the athlete is with in 1 year of the age group there will be a 1 point deduction.

If the athlete is outside of the 1 year ruling there will be a 3 point deduction.

If there is 2 or more out of age athletes in any given team they will compete as exhibition and receive scoresheets and rankings but not be eligible for awards. If teams do not disclose this in writing prior to the event and it is brought to our attention before, during or after the event we have he right to disqualify the team.

Note: Policy is only available for ACSA divisions, no out of age athletes are permitted in any IASF divisions at any event.

STUNT

We will no longer be offering assisted partner stunt, group stunt or partner stunt at events.

CHEERSTARS / DANCESTARS

CheerStars & DanceStars were designed to bridge the gap between recreational and competitive cheer & dance. Please email us for a link to all the resources, including rules, free music & routine layout.

We will continue to offer these divisions as per age grid below. Please contact dani@cheercon.com.au for the information and rules.

- Tiny 4-6 years - Mini 4-9 years - Youth 4-12 years - Junior 4-16 years
- Senior 4-18 years Open 14+ - Adult 18+

DANCE DOUBLE'S (DUOS)

We will only be offering Open Pom and Open Hip Hop duos, this is to fall inline with what the ICU offer at Worlds. These will be judged on the ICU scoresheet.

Time limit for Dance Double's will be 1 minute and 30 seconds

- Open 14+ - Adult 18+

DIVISION SPLITTING

CheerCon will split the division based on team size if a division has ten or more teams entered. We do NOT specify these team sizes but rather split the division as equally as possible based on the sizes of teams entered into that competition. Whilst it is common in the Cheer Industry, CheerCon does not split based on enrolment numbers.

E.g. If ten teams enter Junior 2 and the athletes are 10,11,12,14,17,20,22,23,25,30, then division A will be teams with 10-17 athletes, and division B will be 20-30 athletes. If the size of the team changes after the work order is final, we will not move the team into the other division, nor will you be penalised.

CROSSOVER RULES

CheerCon will allow a 3 level Crossover rule:

- •CheerStars R1 Level 1 CheerStars R3/S3 - Level 5
- •CheerStars S1 Level 2
- Novice Level 2
- •Level 2 Level 4

- CheerStars R2/S2 Level 4
- •Level 3 Level 5
- •Level 1 Level 3
- •Level 4 Level 7

MULTIPLE CLUB REGISTRATION

Athletes can only belong to a maximum of 2 x Allstar clubs and only split if one is for cheer and the other is for dance. Athletes can crossover from Allstar to Scholastic/University but only belong to one Scholastic or University Club.

Athletes are also not permitted to compete against themselves at events, e.g you can not be in 2 x Open Advanced Jazz routines.

DANCE

CheerCon will allow 1 level crossover by genre only.

SCORING

SCORESHEETS

CheerCon follows all ACSA scoring, scoresheets & rubrics information and the IASF rules for 2023-2025. CheerCon also follows all CheerStars scoring & rules as outlined in the CheerStars info pack.

CheerCon will use the IASF scoresheets for ALL Worlds divisions (Levels 5-7) at all events.

DEDUCTION & RANGE REVIEW

We will use Hit Zero for all scoring. Gyms are required to nominate one person who will receive texts with deductions and ranges for each team as each judge submits them. You can check these online and contest if necessary within 30-minutes of receiving the deduction/range. We recommend all questions go through the Hit Zero system even if you are not contesting. Video replay is available at all events to check before sending in questions or contesting. Please note: the contesting judge's ruling is final.

SCORESHEET DISTRIBUTION

Scoresheets will be available on Hit Zero within 24 hours of the event finishing.

TIE BREAK RULES

In the event of a tie, we will follow the ruling below to decide who receives the highest placing:

- 1. Cheer/Dance: Team with fewer deductions
- 2. Cheer: The team with the highest quantity of scoresheets out of the 5-panel judges scoring higher,

le. Team 1 - J1: higher, J2: higher, J3: higher

Team 2 - J4: higher, J5: higher

- = Team 1 will place ahead of Team 2
- 3. Dance: Team with higher dance-specific difficulty/execution score
- 4. Dance: Head judge to make the final call

EVENT DAY

PERFORMANCE SURFACES

Icebreaker/State/Champions League:

Dance: 8-panel vinyl floor (12m x 12m) Cheer: 9-panel sprung cheer floor (54f x 42f)

Worlds Experience & Nationals:

Dance: 10-panel vinyl floor (15m x 12m) Cheer: 9-panel sprung cheer floor (54f x 42f)

CRAZY FAN ZONE

Fans can now come down from the stands and support their favourite teams nice and close to the performance surfaces. These seats are not managed by staff; it is the responsibility of spectators to vacate the seats between each performance.

WARM-UP ROOM

All teams receive an adequate warm-up session before their performance time in a scheduled and organised warm-up space. The warm-up room will have a sound system and provide AUX and lightning connection.

Icebreaker/State/Champions League:

Cheer: Open space, 1 panel cheer floor, 3-5 extra panel hard mats, x 17 metres sprung tumble strip, 1 x 9-panel hard mat

Dance: Open space, 1-5 extra small vinyl strips, 1 or 2 x 8-panel dance surface

Worlds Experience:

Cheer: Open space, 3-5 extra panel hard mats, x 17 metres sprung tumble strip, 1 x 9-panel hard mat

Dance: Open space, five extra small vinyl strips, 1 x 10-panel dance surface

Nationals:

Cheer: 2 x full 9 panel floors
Dance: 4 x 8 panel dance floors

MUSIC

All teams must have a designated music person who can attend warm-up with the team and will then play their music from the sound desk when they take the floor.

AWARDS SESSIONS

Depending on the size of the event day, we may run awards in a separate hall throughout the day, or we may run awards after each session in the main arenas. This will be noted on the final work order three weeks out from each event.

FIRST AID

The first aid officer will be located near the warm-up room and performance surface.

SUBSTITUTIONS & REPLACEMENT ATHLETES

- Substitutions may be made in the case of any injury or other serious circumstance.
- Substitutes must also abide by the age restrictions in all divisions and the associated rules and regulations.
- In case of a last-minute injury or illness where you have no safe way to replace an in-age/level athlete, you can compete with an out-of-age/level athlete. This person must declare they are out of age/level at warm-up check-in and will wear a neon band on their ankle for transparency between gyms and judges. If the athlete is out of age please refer to the *OUT OF AGE POLICY*

"SIDELINE" COACHING

A general rule infraction will apply to teams where coaches are seen to be coaching from the "sideline" of the performance to assist their athletes.

Exception; Tiny & Mini Novice & Cheer/DanceStars coaches may assist via sideline coaching but only from the two front corners, not in front of the floor. It will be a general rule infraction for any assistance given outside this area or if coaches enter the performance surface during the routine.

TINY & MINI NOVICE & CHEER/DANCESTARS RULES

- It will be permitted for sideline coaches to use props to help prompt athletes; however, there are to be no props or visual aids on the performance surface to assist with formations and positions.
- A total of 2 x gym owners or coaches may assist tiny athletes onto the performance surface but must abide by the 30-second time allocation to get on and off the floor. Exceeding this will incur a rule infraction.
- Teams that take longer than the time allocated to start their routine will be disqualified and asked to leave the performance surface.
- Teams with spotters on the floor, must follow the general spotter's rules and attire.
- Deductions will apply for spotters assisting with skills on the performance surface like all other levels and divisions.

SAFETY SPOTTERS

A safety spotter is an additional person who is NOT part of the team but takes the floor with the team to provide a safety spot. All safety spotters must be registered gym owners, coaches or athletes for that event. They must be dressed in plain black clothing and wear appropriate soft-soled shoes. Safety Spotters must not be eating and cannot be wearing jewellery or lanyards of any kind. If a spotter is not abiding by these rules, assists with a stunt or counts for the athletes, the team will receive a general rule infraction.

Spotters for group & partner stunts can assist with catches from dismounts but are not there to assist with skills, transitions or mounts. Assisting can incur a deduction.

PHOTOS & VIDEOS

We would like to invite people to video and photograph their own team's routine on the day.

However, please be mindful of other spectators watching the performance and stay seated, not standing or sitting in front of marked performance space or judge's areas. Please be respectful to the athletes and avoid flash photography for their safety. We will have professional photography and video at each event. We encourage everyone to put their phones down and enjoy their athlete's routines first-hand instead of behind a screen. Photos & Videos will be available via cheercast.com.au. Each gym and its families can create a free login to see their program routines.

INJURY / SPILL RULES

If there is an injury in the warm-up room or the music/routine has to be stopped during their performance due to an injury, the team will be given the option to perform their routine again at the end of the session or the next viable changeover. The second routine will only be judged from the time the injury occurred and onwards; however, the team must compete their full routine. Gym owners & coaches are also now in charge of cleaning the surfaces affected by their athletes' bodily fluids in the warm-up room or the performance space.

COPYING CHOREOGRAPHY

If any team is seen to have choreography copied from an external gym, a formal complaint can be made to Dani or Alex Jimenez. If it is found that any routine has more than 32 counts of copied choreography, the routine will be disqualified, and any awards will be removed from the team.

Other Notes

- Upon arrival, Athletes & Coaches check in and collect their wristbands individually with the CheerCon staff. Gyms will be invoiced for any athlete who comes to collect a wristband on the day and is not on the registered list.
- It will be assumed that any athlete unable to maintain a standing position requires medical attention and will be treated as such. A Coach, Gym owner, Event provider or the legality judge is permitted to stop the routine should they have concerns for the safety of an individual.
- CheerCon is aware that injuries and illness can affect team numbers between registration closing and the event day. For this reason, we will count athletes at warm-up check-in and inform the judging panel of any necessary changes.
